



Jane's Place Child Advocacy Center

Jane's Place is both a place and a team of people. Our Center provides a safe, youth-friendly place for child and adolescent victims of abuse (ages 0-18) to be interviewed, receive medical exams, and work with a therapist. It's a warm, inviting location where the child's needs come first and non-profit offending family members can find support and helpful resources.

Our Team is made up of professionals from Child Protective Services, law enforcement, WMHS, mental health agencies, State's Attorney's Office, and Jane's Place staff. Together we discuss and make decisions about the investigation, management, and prosecution of child abuse cases. We also work to prevent child victimization within our rural community.
